Participants are supported to practice using evidence-based and best-practice frameworks that create sustainable tenancies.

Key learning outcomes

- Identify risk factors for housing instability
- Practice applying Wellways housing principles
- Practice developing a housing action plan using a Housing First approach

Wellways uses the principles of choice, sustainability and social connectedness in this training, and recognise that when all of these elements are secured, people have a greater opportunity to live a good, sustainable life.
